



## The Creativity Group Scholarship

The aim of this scholarship, set up by the C-Group, is to enable a practising teacher to attend and present at the 55<sup>th</sup> IATEFL Conference in Belfast.

The award consists of:

- Registration for the IATEFL Conference
- A year's IATEFL membership
- A maximum of GBP 800.00 to include:
  - Travel costs receipts necessary
  - 4 nights' accommodation receipts necessary

To qualify you must:

- be a practising teacher in tertiary, primary or secondary education, either in the state or the private sector
- have been a teacher for less than 10 years
- have not presented at an IATEFL Conference before
- agree, if you win the scholarship, to give a talk or workshop on the topic of creativity during the conference
- agree, if you win the scholarship, to submit a report by May 2021 for possible publication in *Humanising Language Teaching Magazine*, describing your creative idea
- agree, if you win the scholarship, to become a member of the C-Group and post a short report on your experience at the conference on the C-Group blog

To be considered you must submit:

- an online speaker proposal for the conference related to the topic of creativity by the scholarship deadline
- an essay of between 400 and 500 words of ways in which you think you can contribute to encouraging creativity in your context either in your workplace or among other teachers in your country. (Note that this is different from the proposal; your statement should focus on other aspects of your work on creativity, rather than on the proposal that you are submitting for the conference)

The submission deadline is **16.00 (UK time) on Wednesday 28 July 2021**. Early submissions are very welcome; late submissions will not be considered.

The result of your application will be emailed to you between **25 August and 8 September 2021**. Please do NOT contact the IATEFL Head Office about scholarship decisions; the Scholarship Committee will send everyone the results as soon as they are available.
