- ☐ reads through the final draft cover to cover,
- ☐ identifies errors and inconsistencies in style/ formatting/ grammar/ spelling, and referencing, and above all,
- ☐ provides a fresh pair of eyes and a final polish.

Interested applicants should have

- ☐ copy editing experience and/or a qualification in copy editing,
- ☐ have an ELT or education background, and
- ☐ be a passionate pron-thusiast, or if not, be confident to work with content relating to pronunciation.

We publish Speak Out! twice per year and each issue is approximately 60 pages. The copy editor will have 3-4 weeks in January and again in August to work on the issues and send any feedback on to the editorial team prior to publication.

Please note, as the copy editor will only be working on the journal twice per year, this role will not be a committee position.
