



## **Cambridge University Press & Assessment Scholarship**

This scholarship, funded by the Cambridge University Press & Assessment, gives the opportunity for anyone with an interest in English Language Teaching to attend the IATEFL Conference.

## The scholarship consists of:

- registration for a pre-conference event of your choice
- registration for the IATEFL conference
- a year's IATEFL membership
- a maximum of five nights' accommodation up to GBP 130.00 per night (against receipts)
- travel costs up to a maximum of GBP 1000.00 (against receipts) \*
- £55.00 per day expenses for five days

\*This includes the cost of economy flights and airport transfers. Cambridge University Press & Assessment will not cover the costs of stopovers.

## To qualify you must:

- work in the fields of English language teaching or language assessment or be a post-graduate student focusing on teaching/assessment issues
- agree to write an article by the end of September 2026 about how attendance at the conference has enriched your practice
- comply with IATEFL's scholarship policies

## To be considered you should submit:

• A 550-600-word essay on the following topic:

Outline what kind of teacher development activity you believe to be impactful in leading to real change in teaching practice. Please give an example of teacher development activity which you designed or undertook, which has had a lasting impact on your, or a trainee's classroom practice, and the learners. What was the development activity and how was it put into practice? How do you know it was successful?

The submission deadline is **16.00 (UK time) on Wednesday 18 June 2025**. Early submissions are very welcome; late submissions will not be considered.

The result of your application will be emailed to you between **12 and 22 August 2025**. Please do NOT contact the IATEFL Head Office about scholarship decisions; the Scholarship Committee will send everyone the results as soon as they are available.
