



The IATEFL TTEdSIG Early-Career Teacher Educator Scholarship

The aim of the Early-Career Teacher Educator Scholarship, set up by The Teacher Training and Education Special Interest Group, is to provide early-career teacher educators with an opportunity to attend the TTEdSIG PCE, give a short 20-minute presentation at the PCE, and attend the IATEFL conference.

This scholarship is for early-career teacher educators, which the TTEdSIG defines as teacher educators who have been in their position or have been carrying out their role for no more than five years. One does not need to have the defined position of 'Teacher Educator' or 'Teacher Trainer' to be considered a teacher educator. Additionally, to be considered for this scholarship, you must be a member of the TTEdSIG.

The scholarship consists of:

- Registration for the TTEdSIG Pre-Conference Event
- Registration for the IATEFL Conference
- IATEFL TTEdSIG membership (as full individual IATEFL membership or additional SIG)
- 750 GBP towards accommodation, expenses, and travel costs

To qualify you must:

- Be a current IATEFL member and a member of TTEdSIG
- Be an early-career teacher educator who has been:
 - o working in the position of or performing the role of a teacher educator for less than five years
 - o involved in teacher education and/or training for less than five years
- Agree to do these things:
 - o Give a 20-minute presentation or lead a workshop at the TTEdSIG PCE (the content of which is linked to the essay you write for the scholarship)
 - o Complete a short, recorded interview with the TTEdSIG team, discussing your experience
 - o Write a 600-word reflective article for the TTEdSIG newsletter

To be considered you must submit:

A training session plan that you have delivered in the last 12 months with an accompanying set of notes. This
can be any length of session, on any topic, for any group of teachers, trainers, etc. that you have worked with
in a training capacity. Please also include a set of notes (maximum 1000 words), detailing your rationale behind
the session and your reflections on how it went

The submission deadline is **16.00 (UK time) on Wednesday 18 June 2025**. Early submissions are very welcome; late submissions will not be considered.

The result of your application will be emailed to you between **12 and 22 August 2025**. Please do NOT contact the IATEFL Head Office about scholarship decisions; the Scholarship Committee will send everyone the results as soon as they are available.
