

IATEFL Special Interest Group (SIG) Pre/Post Conference Event (PCE) 2021 Terms and Conditions



These are the terms which govern your attendance at, and/or participation in, an IATEFL Pre/Post Conference Event (PCE) in 2021 (referred to subsequently as “the event”). By booking for this event you are agreeing to these terms, as well as those of our event platform, Zoom <https://zoom.us/terms>, which form a legal contract between IATEFL and the registered participant. If you are booking on behalf of another delegate, it is your responsibility to ensure that the person attending is aware of, understands and accepts these terms.

IATEFL reserves the right to modify these terms and conditions. Please visit the particular event information on the IATEFL website for the most up-to-date version.

1. The Event

- a. Payment of the event fees entitles you to a single access to the online platform upon which the event will be held. This access must not be shared with other people, or projected in order to allow multiple people to participate through one delegate booking.
- b. IATEFL reserves the right to alter any or all aspects of the event (including, but not limited to, the event name, content, programme, presenters, online platform and time) without liability to delegates for expenses that may have been incurred.

2. Booking & Attendance

- a. Bookings must be made online, and can be paid for either online, by bank transfer, or by calling IATEFL Head Office.
- b. Payment of event fees must be made in full before login details to the event platform are provided.
- c. If a company or institution is paying on behalf of a delegate, it is the delegate’s responsibility to ensure payment is made in time.
- d. If you wish to benefit from the member discount you must hold a valid membership at the time of your booking and payment, and ensure you are logged into the IATEFL website with your membership account before making your booking. Refunds of payments made in error using non-member rate fees will not be issued.
- e. If the named delegate is not able to attend, the booking cannot be transferred to another individual.
- f. IATEFL reserves the right to remove you from the event platform if IATEFL considers your presence and/or behaviour to create a disruption or to hinder the conference and/or the enjoyment of the conference by other attendees. IATEFL’s [code of conduct](#) will apply to all participants in the event.
- g. Delegates must not use the event, or event platform, to promote their own products or services, or the products and services of a company or organisation during the event. IATEFL reserves the right to remove the delegate(s) with no right to refund, in such circumstances.

3. Event Speakers

- a. Any opinions, ideas and information given within a conference session by a speaker or other participant should not be necessarily regarded as factual, and do not represent the views of IATEFL.

4. Cancellations

- a. Any cancellations must be made in writing to IATEFL Head Office. There is no right to refund unless the event is cancelled by IATEFL, and any refund will be at the discretion of IATEFL.
- b. IATEFL holds no liability should a specific event or session within the event be cancelled.
- c. For all services provided by IATEFL which are dependent on the virtual platform provided by Zoom. IATEFL cannot reasonably control such virtual provision and so cannot be held liable for any technical issues experienced by the platform. Neither will IATEFL accept liability for technical issues, outside of its control, experienced by any user of the platform. As such IATEFL cannot provide refunds, or be held liable for any costs incurred by such circumstances
- d. IATEFL cannot provide refunds, or be held liable for any possible effects of the United Kingdom leaving the European Union or a Coronavirus Event. Such effects are outside of the control of IATEFL. A Coronavirus Event is an event or delay caused by, or arising from or in relation to the Coronavirus (being Covid19/ SARS-COV2 Coronavirus or any mutation or development thereof) epidemic or pandemic that prevents, postpones, cancels or delays any bookings, sales or refunds by the Company under this agreement and other contracts with third parties, or performance of any obligations by the Company under this contract, including (but not limited to) losses and disruptions which caused such delay or postponement of sale, bookings or refunds.
- e. Without limitation to any other provision of this agreement IATEFL shall not be in breach of this agreement nor liable for delay in performing, or failure to perform, any of its obligations under this agreement, or obliged to provide refunds if such delay or failure results from events, circumstances or causes beyond its reasonable control. In such circumstances it shall at its sole discretion be entitled to reschedule to a date more than 18 months after the original date of the Conference.

5. Privacy

- a. We will process your personal data lawfully in line with IATEFL [Privacy Policy](#).
- b. When using the online platform on which the conference will be run, your data will also be protected by the platform: <https://explore.zoom.us/trust/privacy>.
- c. Please note that you may also appear in a video recording, your comments may be recorded and you can exchange contact details with other event participants. The lawfulness of this processing is based on your consent which is presumed by your participation and by providing contact details.
- d. By attending the event you acknowledge and agree to grant IATEFL the right at the event to record, film, photograph or capture your likeness in any media and to distribute, broadcast, use or otherwise globally to disseminate such media without any further approval from you or any payment to you.



6. Liability

- a. Our aggregate liability to you, whether such liability arises in contract, tort (including negligence) or otherwise, for any damages, loss, costs, claims or expenses of any kind however arising, out of in connection with any booking (or requested booking) made by you or otherwise in relation to this event, shall be limited to the price paid by you in respect of your booking to attend the conference.
- b. We shall not be liable to you for (i) any loss of profit, loss of or damage to data, loss of anticipated savings or interest, loss of or damage to reputation or goodwill or; (ii) any indirect, special or consequential damages, loss, costs, claims or expenses of any kind.
- c. You agree to indemnify us, our staff and our partners and to hold us harmless to the fullest extent permitted by law, against all loss, costs, claims or expenses of any kind arising from any act or omission by you during the event.
